## **GUIDELINES FOR TEACHERS.**

## **Guidelines**

- 1. Please do not wear outdoor shoes on the pool-side.
- 2. Please make sure that the only drinks taken onto the pool-side are in sports drinking bottles.
- 3. Please store bags in lockers or in the group changing room, which is available to us for this purpose. The key is held at the club desk and should be returned there once possessions are locked away.
- 4. Please do not bring mobile phones onto the pool-side.
- 5. Please do not teach whilst under the influence of either alcohol or any other substance which may impair your judgement or speed of reaction.
- 6. Please do not eat on the pool-side.
- 7. Please do not smoke on the pool-side.
- 8. Please try to be punctual.
- 9. Please inform us if you know that you will be unable to attend in order that we may make provision to cover your lessons.
- 10. ALL teachers must be prepared to enter the water when necessary.
